Then set the tree in the pot; if the roots are too long for the pot, trim them with secateurs. If planting a fruit tree, make sure that the knobbly part of the trunk (graft union) is level with the top of the pot, and start to backfill with the compost mix, firming the soil around the roots and into the sides of the container.
